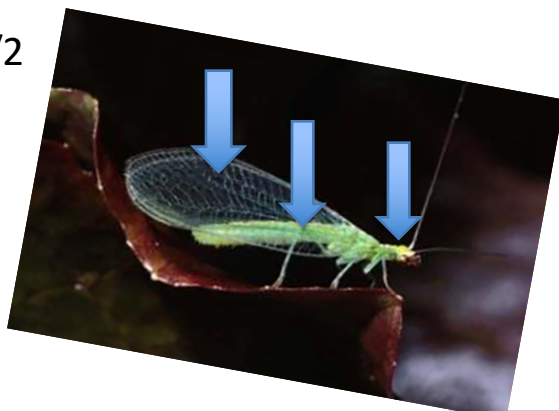

GARDEN VISITOR 2.

- Adults average about 13 mm (1/2 inch) long
- Adult has 4 membranous wings
- Golden eyes
- Soft green body

GARDEN VISITOR 2.



- Eggs on stalks
- 3-20 mm (1/8-4/5 inch) larva
- Pupa in loosely woven, spherical silk cocoons
- Adults emerge about 4 days after egg was laid
