

## CARDEN VISITOR 3.

- Small, adults 3-4
   mm (1/8-1/6 inch)
   long
- Mottled brown color
- Body held at 45° angle when feeding





## CARDEN VISITOR 3.



- Host plants: citrus and closely related plants from Rutaceae family such as mock orange and Indian Curry leaf,
- Life cycle: egg, 5
   nymph instars, adults







 Vector for phloeminhabiting bacteria
 Candidatus Liberibacter asiaticus that causes citrus greening disease (Huanglongbing - HLB)
