Koelreuteria bipinnata (keel-roo-TER-ee-uh) (by-pin-NAY-tuh)




Figure 2. Shaded area represents potential planting range.

- Lives 50 100 years




Interesting Facts











Attractive Qualities

- Used as a patio, shade, street, or specimen tree
- Drought Tolerant
- Thrives in wide range of soil conditions (sand, clay, loam, acidic, etc)
- little to no pests or disease
- Hardy and requires little maintenance
- beneficial impact on air pollution absorbs smog, dust, and other particulate



Growing Requirements

- Light Requirements:
 Prefers full sun
- Water Requirements:
 Average water needs, water regularly but don't overwater
- Climate: Prefers mild climates
- Pruning: Trees need to be trained when young to develop a strong branch structure
