While it is believed that most organic pesticides are less damaging to the environment than conventional pesticides, they are still pesticides. All pesticides should be evaluated before selection for level of toxicity, effectiveness, environmental impacts and costs. Some organic pesticides are as toxic, or even more toxic, than some synthetic pesticides, such as nicotine, copper, sulfur, and even certain formulations of neem oil.

Always read the label on the how to use all chemicals. Most general-use pesticides (organic or synthetic) will cause eye and skin irritations, so using the proper personal protective equipment (i.e. clothing, goggles, shoes, gloves, etc.) to apply the pesticide is crucial to protect yourself. Also, make sure to follow the proper application amount, application intervals and harvest intervals when applying any type of pesticide.
